

SCCA – Chattanooga Chapter #94 -- meeting minutes Thurs April 18, 2013 at O'Charlies, Hixson

Meeting opened at 6:58pm – meeting date was moved up 1 week due to bad weather

- Eric wanted to “go on record saying Thank You to Berry for being open-minded and somewhat attractive.”

Berry – Website status:

- Our '.com' options are to request that the SCCA refuses Jennifer any further membership, she cannot run with us, and we send her a letter stating that we want our money back----however we ultimately don't expect any of this will result in anything
- Our '.org': Berry is working on getting sponsors, but 2 leads did not yield fruit.
- Discussion of needing a Web-Master, which would be a non-board position. This is someone who would manage the web site. We all selected Bob Moates, seeing as he is already pretty much doing that now, and was integral in creating our new site.

Berry: new lot

- Berry has secured a new lot to try out at Walker Valley High School. We will have our June 21st event there – it is exit 30 off I75
- This is, at the moment, a 1-time thing, but if we are happy with it, we will pursue further dates
- We will donate \$250 to the H.S. for usage
- We will get a key to the stadium bathrooms and grounds (fence chain)
- Cho offered to get the van that morning of the event

Berry: new(ish) trailer

- It is at Berry's house – Cho and Phil checked it out and bought it for \$3500 from the Atl chapter
- The exterior needs work, but the rest is good. Old vinyl was removed but lettering outlines are blatantly obvious
- It has new tires, a drop tail, and is 28' long. It is a 2001 model
- Our exterior options are to have it painted, vinylled, plasti-dipped, or wrapped
- Vinyl and dipping are estimated to be about \$500, 1 solid color, before labor cost
- A reasonable estimate to paint it came in at \$1800
- Berry will check on shiny white cost of vinyl – some questioned the long term integrity of dipping

Cho- treasurer update:

- Checking has ~\$5378 and savings has ~\$4001 for \$9379 in accounts.
- March event netted \$1335.50
- Cho is **STILL** going to research the cost of 50 new cones, pricing black base vs. solid
- Second cone trailer: the new one is coming soon, and we will modify our current (new) one to become a bit larger – it needs 8-12” more room as the cones are packed too tightly on it, making it very difficult to stack or remove

Randy – Charity/Solo event update:

- Sponsorships are hard to get – not many so far
- Cruise-in part is looking good
- He is making nice trophy for the autocross part
- Volunteers are needed for drive-alongs

OTHER:

- June 1st is the first Street Survival – will be at Eastgate Mall. We have lots of instructors, and approx 9 students registered already but need more
- Gerald has arranged for the water truck again
